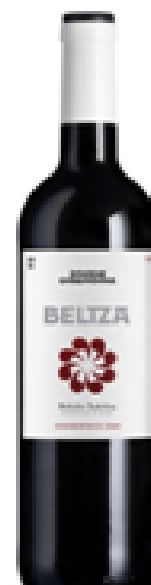


Deeper yellow.
Its maturity and character denote aromas of greater intensity. Ripe fruit, herbaceous and the result of working with lees. Its body and roundness show the elegance of a good evolution without losing, of course, its identity.

The garnet contrast shows the evolution of this wine. Vegetable and fruity aromas begin to give way to the development of notes such as dried pepper and coffee. A robust, wild and tannic wine.

Straw yellow.
Subtle but marked aromas. Dried herbs, thyme and dill. Unbreakable minerality. Voluminous in the mouth, slight bitterness and with a character that faithfully expresses the Bakio coast.

Alcohol content: 13%

Total sulphurous: 74 mg/l

The ruby begins to evolve, slowly and subtly. Without losing its vegetable and earthy identity, tasty and playful aromas of red fruit, yogurt and lavender stand out. Exquisite body and persistent finish. Definitely, a wine with character.

Straw yellow with green iridescence.
Subtle as the sea breeze remind of its origin. Citrus, herbaceous and light bakery. Refreshing, with an easy entry but filling. Accompanying informal moments or complex meals.

Total sulphurous: 75 mg/l

Reby color.
Naturalness of a red Txakoli. Vegetable and fruity, with pepper and hints of the garden. In the mouth it takes us to its origin. The freshness of the sea and the permanence of the forest, with earthy touches that emanate a wild sensation.

2019

Winter drier and colder than usual. Clear days and optimal pruning conditions. Early and uniform sprouting between the end of February (low and sheltered plots) and mid-March (higher altitude plots). Spring with rain, mild temperatures and thermal sensations at the end of the season. Summer with little precipitation (concentration in storms) and sunny days. The sea breeze moderated the temperatures. Late veraison and slow ripening; entry into autumn of the south wind. Harvest in excellent conditions and extraordinary grape health.



2020

Short and dry winter. Early spring especially sunny, with usual rainfall. Flowering at the end of May, with good fruit set. Cycle slowed by cool temperature in June. Veraison at the end of July. The August sampling indicates an advanced of the harvest. September with very sunny days, good day/night gradient and entry of south wind. It is harvested on September 14. The vegetative cycle shortened by 5 days compared to 2019. There is a tendency towards early sprouting and an advanced vegetative calendar, compensated by our characteristically long vegetative cycle.



2021

Winter drier than usual; good pruning conditions. Early spring, mild and sunny weather. At the of February the warmest and most sheltered vineyards were already sprouting. Flowering at the beginning of June, with good weather and relatively fast. The hail on June 16 caused damage in the eastern zone of the Basigo area, which fortunately healed well. Continuation, with cool, cloudy, humid weather but little precipitation. Veraison was uneven from August 15 to September 5. Sunny ripening, and fresh at the end. Harvest staggered in three phases, with cool temperatures for the time.
